Executive Summary

- Permit issuance criteria: severity of emergency event, potential ecosystem and health impacts, availability of alternative mitigation measures, bypass duration and monitoring requirements
- Permit conditions: volume limitations on bypass flows, regular MECP reporting, environmental-impact mitigation measures, mandatory post-bypass restoration activities
- Non-compliance consequences: substantial financial penalties, corrective-action compliance orders, possible discharge-permit suspension, MECP legal proceedings
- Incident trend analysis: extreme weather overwhelming facilities, mechanical breakdowns, power outages disabling equipment, operational human error
- Mitigation best practices: modern resilient infrastructure investment, comprehensive emergency response planning, advanced real-time monitoring for early detection, community public education
- Last-resort hierarchy: increased aeration and nutrient supplementation, sludge wasting, flow equalization to wet wells — bypassing only when system is completely overwhelmed

- MBR-specific bypass mitigation: membrane integrity protection, equalization basin utilization, standby power systems, and rapid restart protocols
